
PENTECOST NOVENA 13 – 23 May 2021

- 1) First, read the Prayer Intention for the day. Pray for that intention in your own way.
- 2) Pick one of the 'Prayers for Pentecost' and pray it.
- 3) Think of anyone who may need a prayer today. Pray for them perhaps using the 'Our Father'.
- 4) Ask Our Lady to pray for you and your family by saying the 'Hail Mary'.
- 5) Conclude your time of prayer by saying the 'Glory be'.

For our friends, the animals, especially for the many that are suffering because of humankind.
