Remembrance Sunday

Today is Remembrance Sunday. We will join churches and groups across the country by celebrating Masses of Remembrance, Peace and Hope this weekend. We will also join the Acts of Remembrance at Bridgefoot and Bennetts Rec by keeping two minutes' silence at each Mass to remember those who gave their lives in war and armed conflict, as well as the many civilians and animals who lost their lives.

World Day of the Poor

Today is also the sixth World Day of the Poor. In his message for the day, Pope Francis invites us to greater solidarity and responsibility for the poor. This "is precisely what solidarity is: sharing the little we have with those who have nothing, so that no one will go without." This is the purpose of our annual **Advent collections** which begin today:

1) Warrington Foodbank

The Foodbank exists to provide emergency supplies when people are desperate. Why not buy one extra item when you're out shopping, bring it to church, and we'll take it to the Foodbank.

2) Parish Caritas Fund

If you wish, you could make a donation to our Parish Caritas Fund. We use this money to support those who are struggling through no fault of their own.

3) St Francis Collection

Food, treats and toys to help Warrington Animal Welfare care for the enormous number of animals that are tragically abandoned during the year, especially at present and over the Christmas period.
