#### **Peace Sunday**

Today, the Bishops of England and Wales invite us to observe a Day of Prayer for Peace.

Much has changed since last year's 'Peace Sunday'. War returned to our continent in February with Russia's invasion of Ukraine. Then, in November, the COP27 talks in Egypt brought new focus on the threat that climate change brings to many communities – especially the poorest – due to deforestation, extreme weather events and sea-level rise.

Sometimes it feels as though we have moved backwards in our efforts to bring peace and justice to the world. However, we can and do make a difference by the way we try to live our lives.

Today, perhaps think on these words of Pope Francis: "Let us look within and ask ourselves: are we peacemakers? In the places where we live, study and work, do we bring tension, words that hurt, chatter that poisons, controversy that divides? Or do we open up the way to peace? (1 November 2022).
