Feast of Blessed James Bell

The Feast of our Parish Patron, Blessed James Bell, is this Thursday, 20 April. However, when patronal feasts fall during Advent, Lent or Eastertide, they are transferred to the nearest Sunday in Ordinary Time or to the Sunday before the Solemnity of All Saints in November. So, this year, we will celebrate the Feast of Blessed James Bell on Sunday 29 October.

Changes in Warrington

Many of you will have met Fr Raymond Anyanwu, CSSp, during the last eighteen months. He is a

member of the Spiritan Congregation (formerly known as the Holy Ghost Fathers). I asked Fr Raymond to come and help us in Warrington because your priests are getting older and fewer in number and needed some support. He has been a real blessing to the Deanery. Sadly, his time with us is due to come to an end in June. However, with the permission of the Archbishop and in consultation with Fr Raymond and his Provincial, I can announce that we are able to set up a Spiritan Community in Warrington from 28 April 2023. Fr Raymond will lead the community assisted by another Spiritan, Fr James, from London.

In order for a Spiritan Community to be established it needs a mission. Therefore, it is hoped that Fr James will be the chaplain for Risley Prison and both will serve St Joseph's, Penketh, as parish priest and assistant, as well as continuing to assist Canon Christopher at Sacred Heart and St Alban's.

This arrangement has clearly necessitated some change for St Joseph's. While remaining parish priest of St Paul of the Cross in Burtonwood, Fr John Schofield has graciously accepted the indispensable role Fr Raymond has undertaken – supporting the priests in Warrington and Widnes and assisting with the hospital – in addition to continuing the good work he does in the schools. Fr Mark Drew has kindly agreed to move to St Peter & St Michael in Woolston to serve the parishioners there.
