

#### **First Communions**

This weekend, the children from St Oswald's Catholic Primary School will celebrate their First Communion in two celebrations on Saturday. On 13 May, the children from St Benedict's will do the same. Then, at the end of May and the beginning of June, the children who are at non-Catholic Schools will celebrate their First Communion with us during Sunday Mass. Please keep the children, and their families, in your prayers.

## Coronation of King Charles III

The Coronation of King Charles takes place in Westminster Abbey on Saturday 6 May. It will be an historic occasion.

We are planning to mark the occasion in two ways. First, the weekend Masses on 6 & 7 May will be special celebrations. Then, on Sunday 7 May, together with people all over the country, we will have a Coronation Lunch and Entertainment in St Benedict's Parish Centre, 12.00 noon – 2.30 pm. This will be similar to the Big Lunch we had last year to mark Queen Elizabeth's Platinum Jubilee. If you would like to attend this event, please sign the list at the back of church. There will be a small charge of £3 for adults, but there will be no charge for children.

On Friday 5 May, there will be a Vigil Mass at 5.00 pm in the Cathedral to celebrate the Coronation of King Charles. All are welcome.

## **Bishop Tom Williams**

In February, Bishop Tom Williams reached the age of 75 and, in accordance with Canon Law, submitted his resignation to the Pope. Although Pope Francis has accepted Bishop Tom's resignation, Bishop Tom will continue to assist the Archbishop in a pastoral role.

There will be a Mass of Thanksgiving for Bishop Tom's ministry among us in the Cathedral on Wednesday 17 May at 7.00 pm followed by a drinks reception for all in the Cathedral Crypt. All are welcome.

## Deanery Synodal Council

The Deanery Synodal Council met last week for its sixth meeting. Most of the meeting was spent listening to the feedback from the Parish Listening Sessions that took place across the Deanery during Lent. Signs of hope included the arrival of young Catholic families from overseas who are coming to Mass regularly. The chief cause for concern was that there are less and less people under 60 coming to church. 'Families of Parishes' – most recognise the need to join with other local parishes if we're going to continue to be able to serve the local community. Surprisingly, some were unaware of our Archdiocesan Synod or that our Deanery was now made up of both Warrington and Widnes!

### **Pontifical Divine Liturgy**

As a way of thanking the people of the Archdiocese for their solidarity with the people of Ukraine, Bishop Kenneth Nowakowski will preside at a special liturgy in the Cathedral next Sunday, 30 April, at 3.00 pm. He will be joined by Archbishop Malcolm, clergy from both Liverpool and Ukraine, as well as other civic and religious leaders. Everyone is warmly invited to attend.
