

World Communications Day

Today is World Communications Day. This annual day reminds us of the importance of not just keeping the faith but sharing it. Vital to this is good communication – through websites, publications, and social media channels. So there is a **Second Collection** today to support the Church's work in communicating the Good News in the media.

O God, whose word is truth and in whose light we see light, guide those who tell the story of our times through word and image. Make them seekers after truth and advocates of human dignity. Grant discernment to all who rely on their labours. As we confront the pain and promise of this world, awaken in us a sense of wonder at your presence and of longing for your peace. Sacrament of Confirmation

This weekend, our young parishioners who are in Year 8 in High School will be meeting at St Benedict's at 1.00 pm in preparation for Confirmation. Those at Catholic High Schools have already received catechesis through their RE classes; those not at Catholic Schools are being prepared by Deacon Tony and his team. In June, the young people will join us for a Sunday Mass, visit the Cathedral in Liverpool, and have a BBQ at St Oswald's. Do please keep these young people in your prayers – it's a lot harder to be a Christian these days than when we were their age. They need all the support we can offer them.

Pentecost Sunday

Next weekend, the fifty days of Easter conclude with the great feast of Pentecost. Between now and then, the Church invites us to keep a Novena of Prayer for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit in our lives, in the Church, and in the world. You will find a sheet at the back of church entitled, "Come Holy Spirit", with a short passage of Scripture and a prayer for each day of the week. If you prefer, you could simply pray the age-old mantra, "Come, Holy Spirit!"

Next Sunday morning, the children who attend non-Catholic Schools will celebrate their First Communion with us. There are fifteen children this year. So that we don't over-fill the 10.30 am Mass at St Benedict's, there will be an extra Mass at 12.30 pm. Parishioners are invited to attend either Mass. The liturgy for both Masses will be for Pentecost Sunday.

'Families of Parishes'

This Tuesday, the Deanery Synodal Council will be meeting again. At present, we are exploring the concept of 'Families of Parishes'. In other words, how parishes in the Deanery could learn to work together. Three 'families' have emerged in our discussions so far: the parishes of West Warrington (Sacred Heart & St Alban's, St Joseph's and St Paul of the Cross), the parishes of East Warrington (Blessed James Bell, St Stephen's & St Bridget's, and St Peter & St Michael in Woolston), and the Parish of St Wilfrid in Widnes.
