- With gratitude we honour all those who have gone before us, who have lived out their faith in humble service and handed on their love of Christ to us. We remember especially: Tom Ireland, Rita Devine, Teresa Glover and Hazel Molyneux. In your great love... *R.* Answer me, O God.
- Finally, let us pray quietly for our own personal intentions, for those who have asked us to pray for them, and for all the people of this parish community. (Pause for silent prayer)
 In your great love... R. Answer me, O God.
- Now let us ask Mary, the mother of Jesus, to pray for us all: "Hail Mary..."
