As the Lord welcomes them into the joy of heaven,
may he hold their loved ones in their grief.

- 5 For our own personal intentions,
and for those we've been asked to remember this weekend,
especially Alexander Finney, John Finney, *N. who is to be baptised*
and all the people of this parish community.
