At the heart of this crisis is a struggle over control of the world's seeds. Laws are being brought in whereby small farmers will have to purchase commercial seeds rather than choose their own. While this is good for big business profits it's not good for the farmers. It is likely to put many out of business and exasperate the crisis.
