Racial Justice Day

Today is a Day of Prayer for Racial Justice. Bishop Paul McAleenan, Lead Bishop for Racial Justice, writes: "In the history of the Church, there have been those who looked at the society in which they lived, and responded to what they saw... Alert and sensitive as they were to the commandments of Christ, when they saw justice being denied to someone because of their racial origin or colour, they were prompted to act. Their actions of opposing racism, promoting equality and justice, became their life's work... Sometimes they encountered hostility, rejection, and attempts to overturn what they were doing...
