



Fr. Raniero Cantalamessa O.F.M.Cap, preacher of the Papal household said this, when speaking about Charismatic Renewal, 'I believe at this point it is clear why we say that the Charismatic Renewal is a current of grace for the whole Church. All that the word of God has revealed to us about the new life in Christ - a life lived according to the law of the Spirit, a life as sons and daughters of God, and a life under the Lordship of Christ - is nothing but the substance of Christian life and holiness. It is our baptismal life actualized in fullness, that is, not only thought and believed but lived and presented, and not only to a few privileged souls but to all the holy people of God.'

'I believe the Charismatic Renewal can be (and in part has been) a great help in making the great truths of faith go from being thought to being lived, in making the Holy Spirit move from books of theology to the experience of believers.'





Are we a Martha or a Mary?

Each of us needs to be both a Mary and a Martha. As disciples, we are called both to sit and to serve. We are called both to abide and to bear fruit. We sit and hear Jesus's word. We bow at his feet in worship. We kneel before him in prayer. In all these ways, we follow after Mary's example at the feet of Jesus. It is in this place that we find the discernment, clarity, wisdom, strength, and courage to bring Christ's loving presence into the world.

In our desire to follow God's call by serving him with everything we have, we can easily find ourselves overcommitted, "worried and troubled about many things." Distracted. In a culture that exalts multitasking and a "we-cando-it-all" mentality, we have a teacher who invites us to learn his way and adopt his priorities.
