Dates: Thursdays 30 April, 7 May, 14 May, 21 May

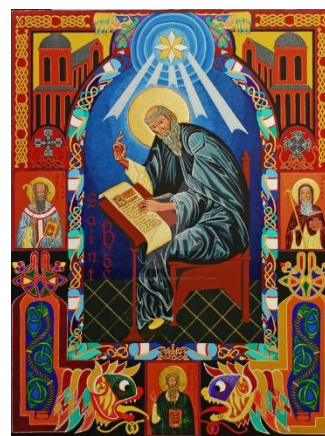
