### Day of Prayer for Victims of Trafficking

Today, 8 February, is the annual Day of Prayer for Victims of Trafficking. Human trafficking now ranks as the second most profitable worldwide criminal enterprise after the illegal arms trade. The practical response of the Church is to raise awareness of this horrendous crime and to provide help and support for the most vulnerable victims.

The day of prayer falls on the feast of **St Josephine Bakhita** (pictured above). St Josephine was from Sudan. At the age of nine, she was kidnapped and sold into slavery. She suffered terribly at the hands of her kidnappers so much so that she forgot her birth name. Her kidnappers gave her the name 'Bakhita' which means 'Fortunate'. She was eventually brought to Italy where she was entrusted to the care of the Canossian Sisters in Venice. It was there that she came to know and experience God's love. Josephine joined the Sisters and for the next fifty years and led a life of simplicity, prayer and service. She was known for showing kindness to everyone, especially the children in the street. In her final years, she suffered from sickness and the haunting memories of the beatings and floggings she received while in slavery. She died in 1947 and was canonised in October 2000.

### National Marriage Week

National Marriage Week began yesterday (Saturday). It is celebrated in the week leading up to Valentine's Day on 14 February. The Archbishop will celebrate Mass in the Cathedral today (Sunday) with married couples

from all over the Archdiocese, and he will pray this prayer:

**God our Father,**  
**we ask you to bless all married couples.**  
**We thank you for their long and happy marriages**  
**and for all the good that they have done.**  
**As you blessed the love of their youth**  
**and helped them in their joys and struggles,**  
**continue to bless their life together**  
**with gifts of peace and joy.**  
**Watch over them in the coming years**  
**and bring them to the feast of eternal life.**  
**We ask this through Christ our Lord.**  
**Amen.**
