Ash Wednesday

The annual Season of Lent begins this Wednesday, 18 February. Ashes will be blessed and distributed during Mass at 11.00 am (St Benedict's) and 7.00 pm (St Oswald's).

The Season of Lent

Easter Day is the most important day of the year for Christians. It's the day Jesus rose from the dead. It was this event that sparked belief in Jesus more than any other and led to the beginning of the Church.

Easter is the time when we welcome new members into the Church. The season of Lent began as a time of final preparation for those who were to be baptised at Easter. For those who were already baptised, Lent became a time for them to prepare to renew their baptism on Easter Day.

Lent is still all these things. On Easter Day, we will stand together and renew our baptism. To prepare for that moment, we use the forty days of Lent to look at our lives and ask: do I need to give something up or do something extra to get back into shape as a Christian?
