- **UPDATED ADVENTUROUS ACCOMPANIMENT DAY WORKSHOP**

19TH September – 10AM-4PM at St Margaret Clitherow Centre

Adventurous Accompaniment is a series of workshops designed to help us explore how, as Christian communities, we walk alongside people through the many different circumstances of their lives. Accompaniment is already at the heart of parish life: it happens when we listen to someone who is grieving; welcome a new family; support a young person; visit someone who is sick; respond to someone struggling with faith or leaning about the faith; or simply give another person our time and attention. The workshops recognise that many people have been doing this instinctively for years, while also inviting us to become more intentional, skilled and reflective in the way we



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accompany others. "Adventurous" accompaniment means being willing to move beyond what is familiar—to encounter people where they are rather than where we might wish them to be, and to journey with them without immediately trying to provide answers or solutions.

CATHOLIC SOCIAL ACTION

- **SHOWING OF PEOPLES EMERGENCY BRIEFING**

Tuesday 15th September – 7PM

There will be a showing of the film People's Emergency Briefing, in the parish rooms of St Anne's, Overbury Street, Liverpool L7 3HJ on Tuesday, 15th September at 7.00 pm.

The film features footage from last November's National Emergency Briefing which brought together leading UK experts in climate science, food security, health, economics, national security and nature. It presents a clear, measured overview of how the climate and nature crisis is affecting everyday life in Britain - and what the evidence says about risks and responses.

The initiative is explicitly non-partisan and has support from a wide range of organisations including National Trust, Church of England, Exeter University, the Royal Meteorological Society, WWF, National Education Union, and many more.

Following the 50-minute film, we will host a 45-minute structured discussion on what this means for our community.

MARRIAGE PREPARATION COURSE

- Are you planning to get married in a Catholic church? The archdiocese is now offering the marriage preparation course for engaged couples. To be led by trained lay facilitators, the 4-session course will help the couples develop skills which could facilitate good communication within their relationship and an understanding of sacramental marriage within Catholic faith.
